Hitta 2-5-1. (Exempel Dm7 G7 Cmaj7)

Markera alla 2-5-1 med t.ex. färg.

Tillvägagångssätt:

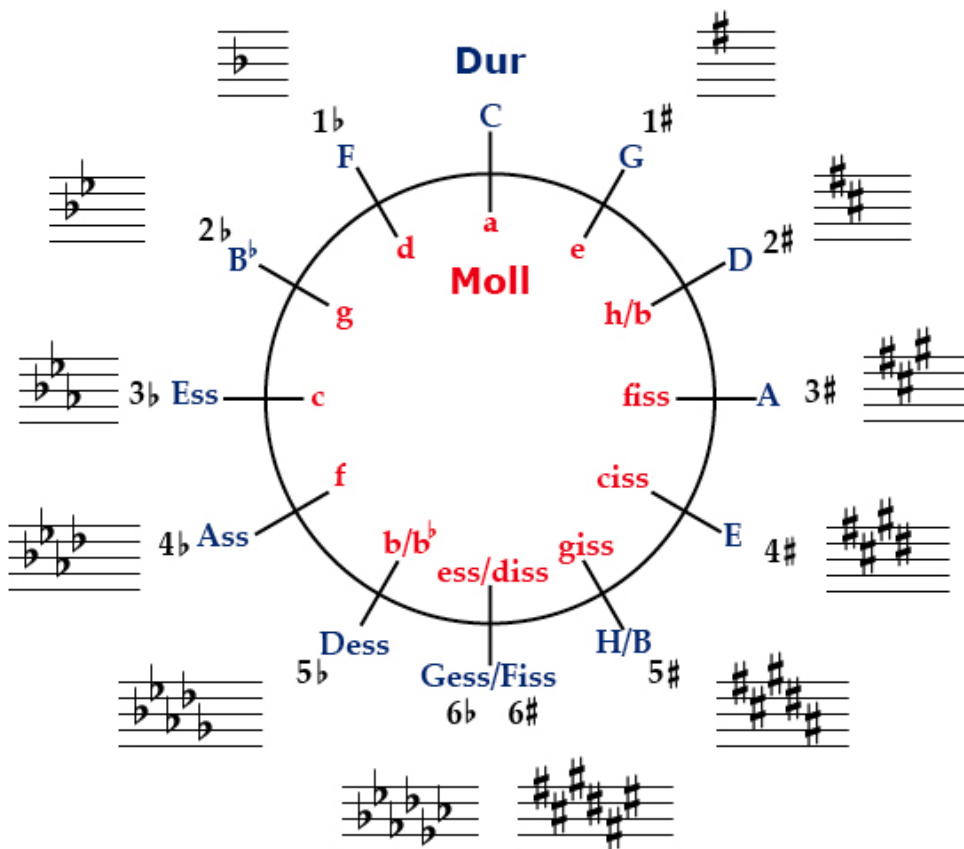
Hitta allt som kan vara "1". (Exempel: C, C6, Cmaj7 men inte C7).

Kolla om ackordet innan "1" är "5". (Exempel G7 före C, eller F7 före Bb)

Kolla om ackordet innan "5" är "2" (exempel Dm7 före G7 C, eller Cm7 för F7 Bb)

UPPGIFT DEL 2:

Testa att spela någon eller flera av fraseerna som finns i 2-5-1-papprena (eller eget liknanade förslag) när respektive 2-5-1 dyker upp.
